New 7.2(19)  Signs may not include text, graphics or pictures defined as obscene in N §31 if taken as a whole it  A. appeals to the prurient interest of the average person applying standards of the county where the offense was committed;  B. depicts or describes sexual conduct in a patently offensive way C. lacks serious literary, artistic, political or scientific value.  Nor may signs depict or describe sexual conduct or sexual excitement a Chpt 272, §31.  Add new subsection 9 to 11.6 (site plan approval criteria)  11.6(9)  A. No signs, text, graphics, pictures, publications, videotapes, CDs, DV covers, merchandise or other objects, implements, items or advertising, describing sexual conduct or sexual excitement as defined in MGL Chp be displayed in the windows or on any building or be visible to the public pedestrian sidewalks, walkways, or bikepaths or from other areas outsice establishments.
